



## **Our Role in Leading Others to Christ**

### **Main Point**

People cannot believe unless someone shares the gospel with them. God uses ordinary believers to bring the message of salvation.

### **Part 1: Master Teacher (10 Minutes)**

#### **Introduction**

**Why do you think God chooses to use ordinary people like us to share the message of salvation?**

Salvation is available to all, but people must hear the gospel. Paul teaches the necessity of proclamation.

#### **Biblical Teaching**

1. Salvation Is Received by Faith (v. 9-10)
  - Believe in your heart.
  - Confess with your mouth.
  - Salvation is a gift of grace.
2. Salvation Is Offered to All (v. 11-13)
  - Everyone who calls on the Lord is saved.
  - No one is excluded.
  - God desires all to come to Him.
3. Believers Are Sent to Share (v. 14-15)
  - People cannot believe unless they hear.
  - Believers carry the good news.
  - Our feet are beautiful when we go. (Isaiah 52:7)

#### **Takeaway**

- Every believer is sent. God uses your voice to bring others to Jesus.

- Encourage confidence rather than guilt.

## Discussion Questions

1. Understanding the Gospel
  - What part of this passage stands out most to you?
  - How does this passage clarify what salvation is?
  - Why is confession important?
2. Seeing People Who Need to Hear
  - Who in your life needs to hear the Gospel?
  - What barriers keep you from sharing with them?
  - How can you prepare to share the Gospel more confidently?
3. Being Sent with the Good News
  - What does it mean to have “beautiful feet”?
  - How has someone’s obedience impacted your faith?
  - What step can you take this week to be sent?
4. Trusting God with the Results
  - Why is it important to trust God and not your performance?
  - How does remembering God’s grace free you to share?
  - How can you pray for a heart that is willing?

## Next Steps & Call to Action (5 minutes)

### Facilitator Closing Thought:

You are God’s chosen messenger to people He loves. He will use your obedience more than your perfection.

### Action Step:

Write down one person and commit to pray for them daily and look for an opportunity to share.

### Prayer Focus:

- Pray for boldness.
- Pray for open hearts.
- Pray for divine appointments.
